Index

This index is designed to help the reader quickly locate parallel discussions of specific topics in the 62 countries and places contained in this *Continuum Complete International Encyclopedia of Sexuality*. With this Index, the reader can compare an issue, such as “sexuality education” or “contraception,” in five-dozen countries. It also guides the reader to issues and topics that are peculiar to certain cultures or countries. Sexual harassment, for instance, is a major issue in European and North American countries, but is hardly or not at all recognized in some South American, African, Eastern European, and Asian societies. Similarly, female circumcision, woman-woman, arranged, and levirate marriages are issues in a few countries, but not in others. Although this Index is a handy guide to all major issues, it is not comprehensive because of the obvious human limitations of the Editors and equally obvious limitations of space. This Index can be used in conjunction with the outline of the main topics provided on the first page of all chapters. A familiarity with the detailed content outline given in the section, “Using This Encyclopedia,” in the front of this book, will also help the reader pursue specific information, since all chapters are structured on this detailed outline.
